Subject: Grant of Recognition to the school from Class I to VIII (without aid w.e.f. academic session 1990-91)

Sir,

With reference to your application on the subject cited above, I am directed to convey the approval of the Director of Education to grant recognition to your school from Class I to VIII (without aid w.e.f. 1990-91 session subject to the following terms and conditions :

1. That the school shall abide by the provisions of the Delhi School Education Act and Rules, 1973 framed thereunder as amended from time to time as well as the instructions re-issued by the Department from time to time.
2. That the school shall appoint full-time qualified and eligible staff as per rules for all the classes of the school as per the norms of the Department.
3. That all the facilities prescribed under Rules 50 and 51 of the DSER, 1973 shall be made available to the students.
4. Provisions of rules 6, 7 and 9 of DSER, 73 shall be strictly observed.
5. That a proper library shall be established and facilities for reading room shall also be made available for the students as well as the teachers immediately.
6. That adequate sports material shall be purchased and made available to the students immediately. More sports material shall be purchased, as and when necessary, as for the norms.
7. That the school shall equip the science Lab. as per the norms of the Department and suitable facilities for practical work shall also be provided to the students.
8. That the school shall admit students without any discrimination of caste and creed and preference shall be given to the students belonging to the area.
9. The payment of salary and allowances etc. to the employees of the school shall be made as per provisions of section 19(1) of Delhi School Education Act, 1973. The staff should be paid full salary with allowances through payees Account cheques before the 7th of every month.
10. That the arrangement of potable drinking water shall be made available to all the students as well as to the teachers and adequate sanitation facilities shall also be provided to the students and the staff.

11. That the enrolment in each section shall not exceed the number of students calculated @ 12 sq. ft. per student of the available floor area of the class room and the school shall provide adequate and sufficient accommodation as per the norms of the Directorate of Education, Delhi in each class. Number of the teaching sections should not exceed the number of the class rooms of proper size in the school.
12. Govt. nominees on the Managing Committee will be asked to meet immediately and all decisions will be taken in accordance with the provision in the scheme of management approved by the D.D.O. (Act).
13. The Managing committee of the school shall not enhance the fees during the academic session without the prior approval of Director of Education which is a mandatory requirement under sub section (3) of section (17) of Delhi School Education Act.
14. That class ninth shall not be started in the school without the prior permission of the Director of Education Delhi.
15. That the violation of any provision of Act and Rules, 1973 and any instruction/order/condition/rule or regulation of the Department shall lead to the withdrawal of recognition of the school.
16. That a report of the fulfilment of the above conditions giving the extent to which each condition has been fulfilled shall be sent to the Education Officer every six months.
17. That the school will file return, as required by Rule 100 of D.S.E.R. 1973.
